ANNOUNCEMENTS

WELCOME guest worship leader Rev. Dr. Giovanni Arroyo, General Secretary (Executive Director) of the General Commission on Religion and Race, to the 9am Metropolitan Memorial and 11am Wesley worship services today!

Rev. Dr. Arroyo, born in Puerto Rico and raised in New York City, is the first-ever Latinx person to head a denomination-wide agency. He started professional ministry in 2001 as pastor of Iglesia Metodista Unida El Camino and served as one of three chaplains caring for families, victims, and survivors of the 9/11 terrorist attack on the World Trade Center. Rev. Dr. Arroyo previously served cross-racial/cross-cultural pastorates in both New York and Baltimore-Washington conferences, while also leading Religion and Race and Hispanic-Latinx ministries.
